

1. Gathering


- Gather at the designated location (confirmed upon admission) and line up in groups.
- Know the number of participants and their physical condition.



- Explanations and notes on how to carry out the activity, safety, etiquette.

3. Directions

- Lay out newspaper and choose a plastic board (bamboo-shaped or heart-shaped).
- Draw your favorite picture or write your favorite words. •The side with the hole faces up.
- If the hole is blocked, remove it with your hand. It's easy to remove. Once you've finished writing, bake it in a toaster oven.



- Use pliers to attach the key chain and you're done!
- Clean up and keep all tools you used in one place

4. Follow-up guidance

- Check on the condition of the guests.
- Collect the borrowed equipment.





Points to note

- 1. Be careful not to get burned.
- 2. Close the caps of the oil-based markers properly, check the number and colors, and then return to the staff.
