Points to note	Gathering - Gather at the designated location (confirmed upon admission) and line up in groups. - Know the number of participants and their physical condition. Advance preparation [Nature House staff, approx, 15 mins.] - Preparation of tools, explanation and precautions, implementation method, safety, etiquette. Directions 1. Draw your favorite letters or pictures on a cedar board using Shoji paste. Draw the letters or pictures large; if they are too detailed or thin, the fire won't penetrate properly, and the glue will spread, causing the design not to stand out. 2. Burn the cedar board with the gas burner. 3. Change the angle when burning the corners of letters and pictures, and the insides of circles. 4. Use a scrubbing brush to remove the charcoal and glue in water, then wipe with a dry cloth. 5. Use a drill to make two shallow holes and attach eye screws. It is made like a screw, so you only need to make a small hole. Attach the string and you're done! Tidy up and keep all the things you used in one place. How to use a gas burner 1.
